7. **Attach the Eyes:** Glue or sew on the googly eyes to bring your kitty cat to life.

8. Stuff and Sew: Stuff the head, body, and tail with stuffing. Sew the pieces together, starting with the head to the body and then the tail.

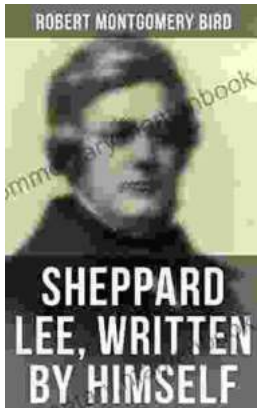

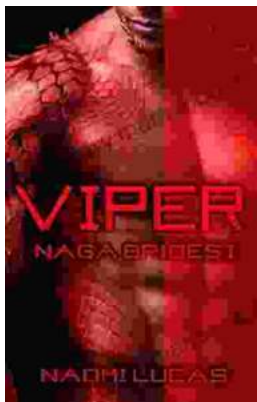
