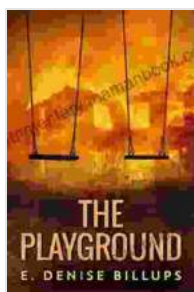


The Playground: A Supernatural Short Story That Will Send Shivers Down Your Spine

The teenager screamed and ran away. The other teenagers followed him, and they didn't stop running until they were safely back home.

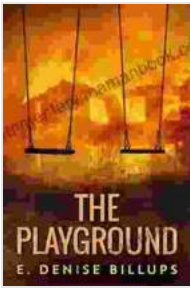

If you ever come across a place that seems haunted, it's best to turn around and walk away. You never know what you might encounter.

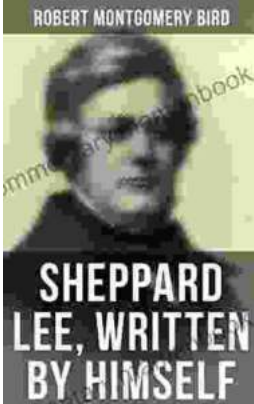

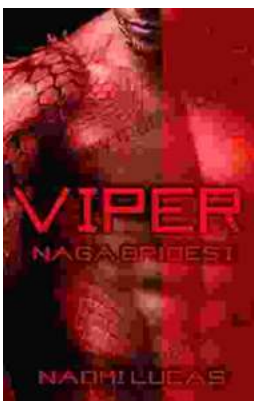
